the Salford ICS Transition Board and will have the opportunity to be able to contribute to the four workstreams and Co-ordination Group. It also appears, although not formally confirmed, that Healthwatch Salford will also be invited to join the new ICS Locality Board.

Likewise I'm also pleased that the HW in Greater Manchester meeting went well, with Warren Heppolette from the Partnership confirming that he'd welcome proposals from HW in GM both about our role (which would be in line with national guidance) and our offer, which would be funded work to help deliver engagement for the ICS. The issue around funding for our role remains unresolved at present.

Our core principles remain: the role of Healthwatch being recognised in the new structures, and clarity over the role of patient and public voice in those structures. These are supported in the attached NHS England Paper on ICS working with communities.
